

# But not everything changed at the same pace A customs office in 2015?




**40% of delays** in the supply chain are due to inefficient administrative procedures (e.g. transmission of paper documents, non-coordinated inspections, etc.)











## Time to Export/Import








# Category A Notifications Received - Regional breakdown





## Category A Notifications received Africa – by Subregion










# Category A Notifications Received 10.4 Single Window
